Birds you must see at O'Reilly's

- Albert's Lyrebird - found nowhere else in the world but not uncommon at O'Reilly's
- Paradise Riflebird - only found in SE Qld and NE NSW but seasonally found feeding and displaying around O'Reilly's grounds.
- Rufous Scrubbird - endangered and extremely secretive but can potentially be found in Antarctic Beech forest a few hours walk from the Guest House. Requires full day private guiding to target.
- Regent Bowerbird - O'Reilly's is arguably the best place in Australia to find them reliably, especially during winter.
- Satin Bowerbird - some of the most reliable viewing anywhere in Australia on O'Reilly's grounds
- Eastern Whipbird - common on east coast Australia but our residents would be the most reliably seen anywhere in the country and regularly approach visitors on the early morning Bird Walk
- Marbled Frogmouth
- Sooty Owl
- Noisy Pitta
- Glossy Black Cockatoo
- Lewin's Rail
- Olive Whistler
- Red-browed Treecreeper
