

At Pat's Chalets, sustainability goes beyond design – it's a promise to preserve the beauty and legacy of the property surrounded by World Heritage-listed Lamington National Park for future generations, all while offering a luxurious escape that inspires a deeper appreciation for the environment.

Sustainability is woven into every aspect of the chalets. Highly efficient insulation and double-glazed windows and doors minimize energy consumption, ensuring year-round comfort with reduced emissions. The cladding, made primarily from recyclable Colorbond® sheeting, reinforces the focus on eco-friendly materials.

The property's 60kVA Solar PV System, interlinked across buildings and supported by battery storage, generates renewable energy, significantly reducing reliance on non-renewable resources. Additionally, Australian-made Colorbond® water tanks, with a combined capacity of 30,000 liters, provide a sustainable water source that complements the natural surroundings.

Also, each Pat's Farm booking includes a donation of \$20 to the Green Mountains Natural History Association (GMNHA) in support of the interpretation and education of visitors to Lamington National Park.

FAQ'S

MAKING THE MOST OF YOUR STAY

Helpful Information

The main entrance door automatically locks when closed. Your pin code will reopen it. The lights in the garage and the entrance landing are motion sensed. Lights will be activated when you arrive or go outside in the dark. They will switch off automatically themselves.

AIRCON SWITCH

The Aircon switch is on the wall near the bathroom entrance - there is a small switch on top of the dial to activate the airconditioning. Use conservatively as you are in an off-grid chalet. Use the same small switch on top of the dial to turn off the unit.

FAN SWITCH

The Fan switch is on the wall near the fridge - bottom right.

POOL LIGHT

Pool light is a switch on the wall near the bathroom entrance. Press switch a number of times to change the colour and mood.

HAMMOCK

The Hammock is stored in the top drawer of the robe cupboard alongside the slippers.

ELECTRIC EXTERIOR BLINDS

The cream remote is on the wall near the fridge and the two blinds have to be operated separately by pushing the middle button to change blinds. While the windows and doors are doubled glazed it is recommended to have the blinds down in the afternoon to stop the western sun heating the chalet.

WEBER BABYQ BBQ

This is also an electric oven and has a dial to set the exact temperature.

HEATED TOWEL RACK

The switch for the heated towel rack is beside the light switches at the entrance to the bathroom.

WOOD

There is more wood outside past the garage next to the bins.

Waste: Red lids: General landfill

Yellow lid: For recyclables,
